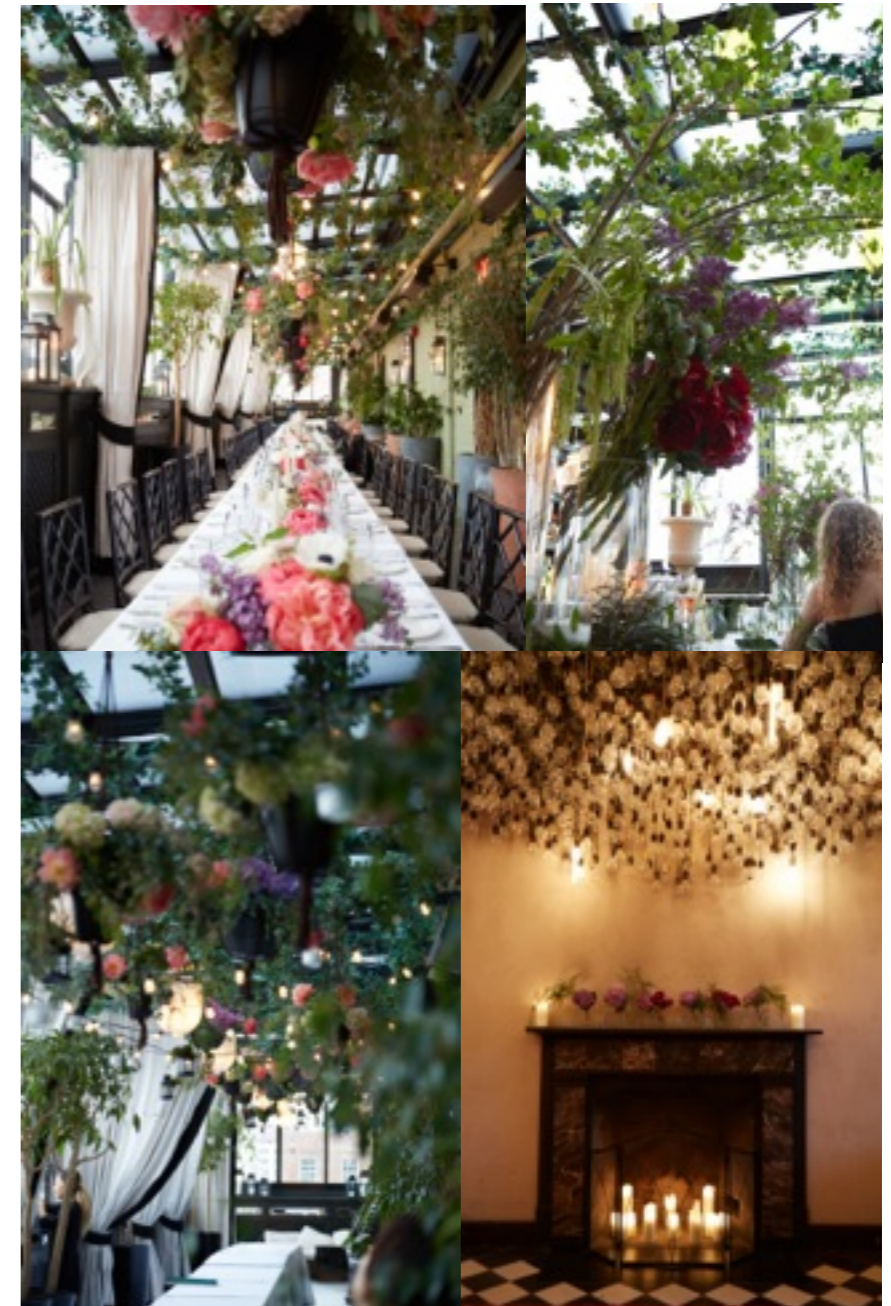

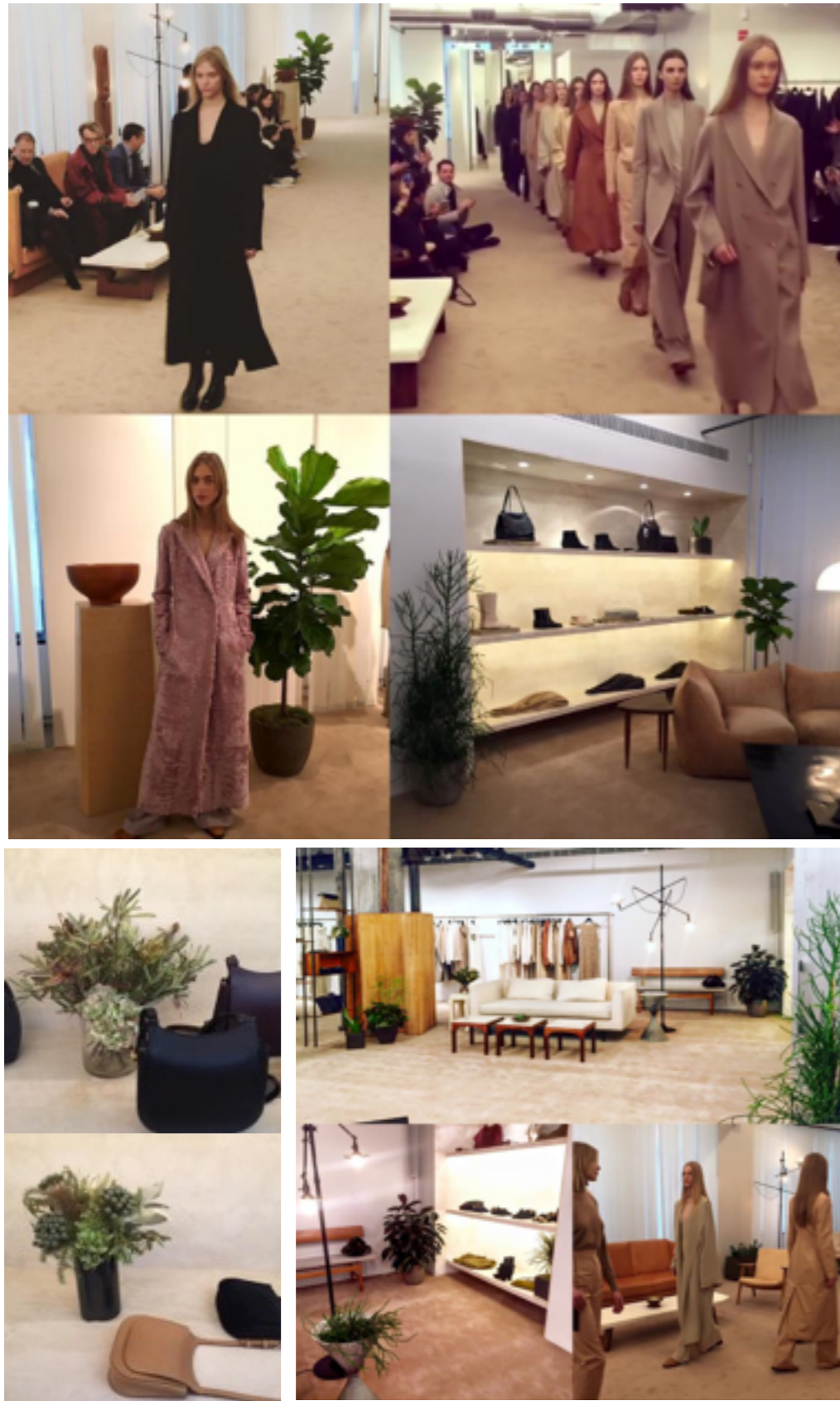

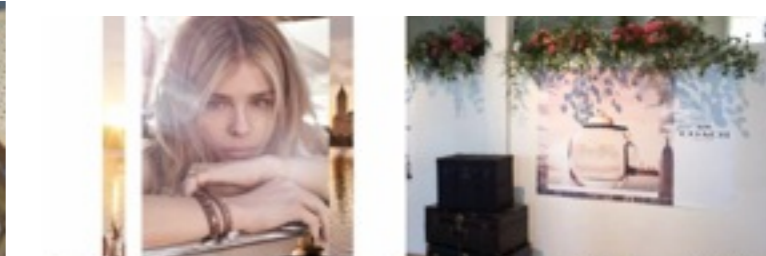

Her creative inspiration is drawn from her love of nature in combination with her deep interest in arts and her client's fashion designs, which translate into her work.

Eriko Nagata was born and raised in Japan.

In 2002, she started her career as a floral designer after studying European design and Ikebana Misho-ryu at one of the best floral design college in Japan.

After working as an exclusive flower designer at The Ritz Carlton Tokyo, Eriko moved to Paris, where she created floral arrangements for various famous fashion brand events, such as Paris Fashion Week, Dior, Hermès... She lives in New York since 2015 and produces floral set designs for shows during New York Fashion Week like Alexander Wang, Phillip Plein... Her clients also include Diptyque Paris, Nike, The Row, Frame, Tiffany, Coach and Japanese-French Restaurant, Mifune. She often takes part in the visual staging of photoshoots as a floral set designer or flower stylist.
